

# Community Recreation Fishing & Boating



- Use of community lakes & beaches require a current PTMD/RDMD Recreation Pass which **MUST** be carried while using the amenities. Patrol Services check for passes. Those without passes will be asked to leave.
- No state fishing license is necessary. Recreation Passes allow for fishing on community lakes.
- No fishing is allowed from back-yards, private docks, the golf course, Lake Water Valley, or in any community ponds.
- The District requires Watercrafts to display a Water Valley registration sticker. Please visit [www.poudretechmetro.org/forms](http://www.poudretechmetro.org/forms) or [www.raindancemetrodistrict.org/forms](http://www.raindancemetrodistrict.org/forms) to register. Registration is free for residents. Once you register your watercraft, you do not need to register it again unless you need a replacement sticker.
- There are three (3) approved boat storage location available for a seasonal fee. The designated storage locations have limited capacity and registration is administered on a first come, first serve basis.
- All other watercraft owners **MUST** adhere to a daily carry-in/carry-out policy. Watercrafts not in compliance are subject to confiscation and fees.
- Residents wishing to access Eagle Lake will need to find appropriate street parking outside of Lighthouse Point. Parking at Lighthouse Point is reserved for Lighthouse Point residents with a parking permit.
